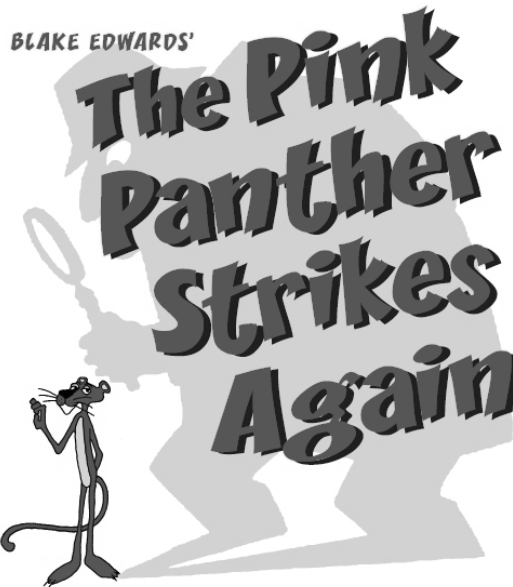
But the world is running out of time!
