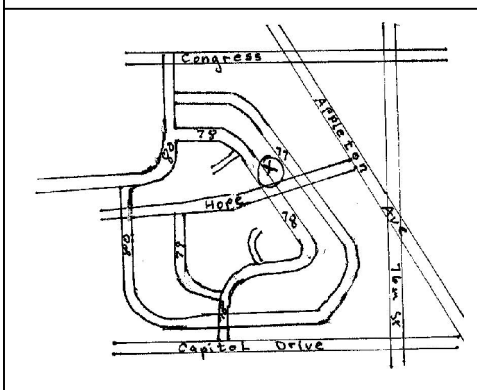
The Plein Air Art Festival
